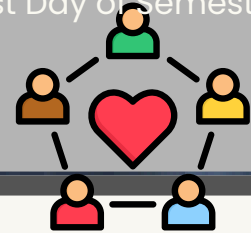

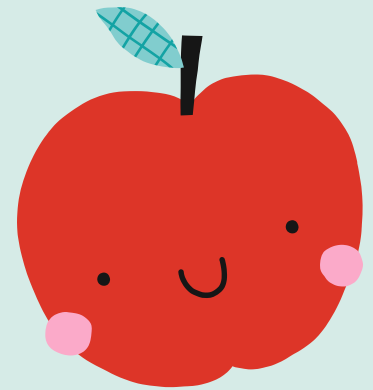
Bus Expectations & Passes

Expectations for bus behaviour have been shared with all students in Elementary and High School. Students are expected to follow the school's Code of Conduct when riding the bus.

When students will be riding as a guest on a bus that they are not registered on, parents/guardians must contact the office to ask for a bus pass. These passes will be signed by Administration and given to students to present to the bus driver when boarding the bus.



This planning must be completed with the office and your child(ren) before 1:00pm on the day of travel. Except in the case of an emergency, bus passes will no longer be given after 1:00pm.

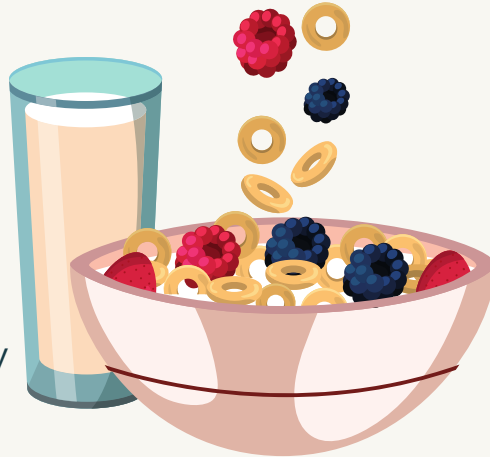

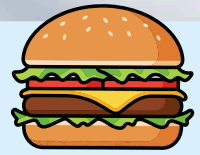

Our January PAC & Annual General meeting will be on Thursday, **January 29 @ 5:30** in the library. All parents and guardians of SESS students are welcome!



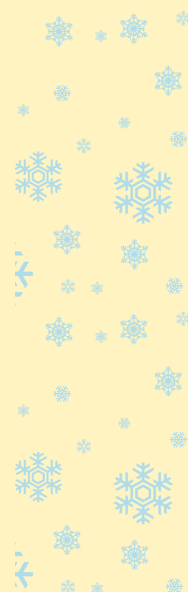
SPORTING EVENTS @ SESS

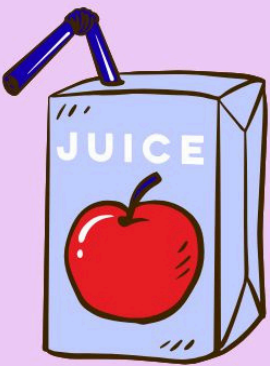

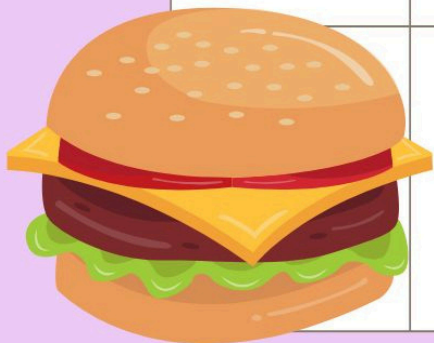
